Latest trends

Christmas sales of fisheries and aquaculture products are expected to be strong this year. However, prices are declining in all main markets, as traders had already bought sufficient supplies of frozen products. There are some exceptions such as shrimp, which show recent price improvements after years of sluggish demand and low price levels. The prices of fresh and live products are also trending upwards, especially for traditional festive products such as lobster and oysters.

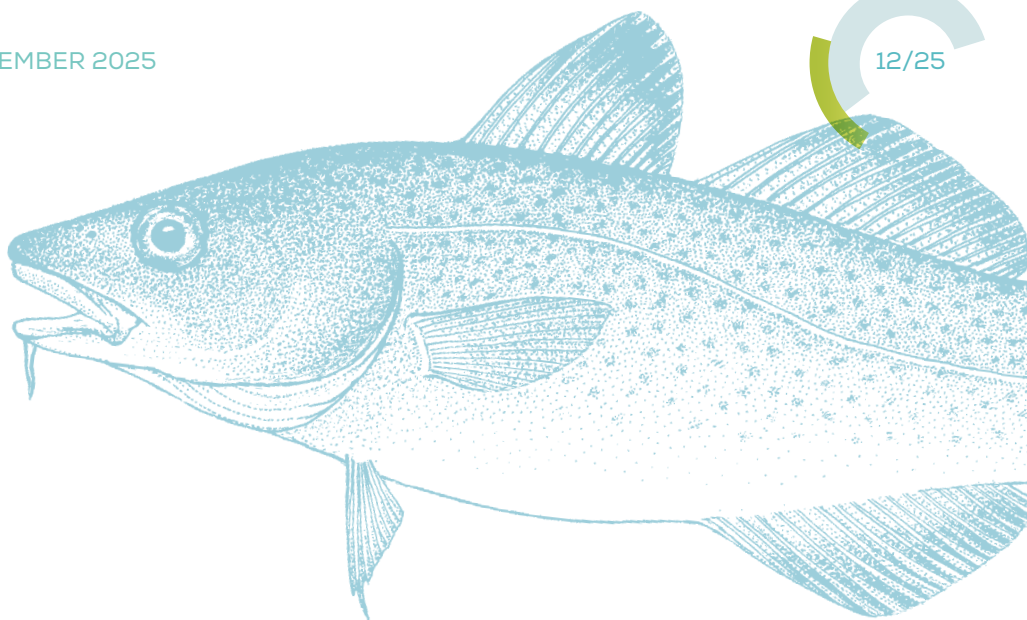
Norway exported NOK 12 billion (USD 1.18 billion) worth of fisheries and aquaculture products in November. This is an increase of NOK 2.6 billion (USD 0.255 billion), or 28 percent, compared with November last year. The cumulative export total so far since January this year is NOK 108.8 billion (USD 10.66 billion), which marks a milestone as it breaks the 2019 record of NOK 107.2 billion (USD 12.5 billion). Taking into account the export value expected in December, the annual record from 2019 will be beaten by around NOK 10–11 billion (USD 0.98–1 billion).

Groundfish



Norway's cod supply is currently tight and historically low due to quota cuts; prices are at record highs, with wholesale values exceeding USD 9 000–9 500 per tonne for Atlantic cod. Norway exported 2 600 tonnes of fresh cod, including fillets, worth NOK 125 million (USD 12.5 million) in November, registering increases of 34 percent in volume and value as compared to November 2024. Denmark, Sweden and Germany were the largest markets for fresh cod from Norway in November.

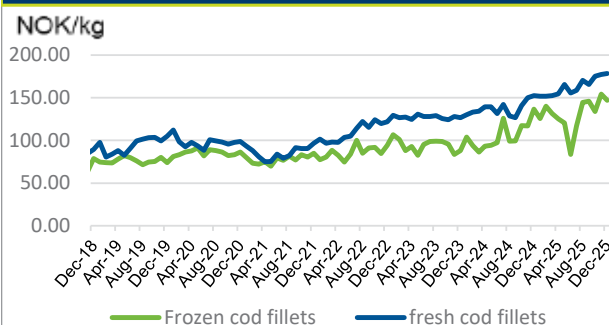
Frozen cod also saw higher exports; in November, Norway exported 8 100 tonnes of the product worth NOK 351 million (USD 34 million). This represents increases of 16 percent and 24 percent by volume and value respectively, compared with the same month last year. The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Poland and China were the largest markets for frozen cod from Norway.

For 2026, Norwegian and Russian scientists have recommended a Barents Sea cod quota of 269 440 tonnes. This is 14 percent lower than the 2025 recommendation and 21 percent below the 340 000-tonne 2025 quota set under the Norway–Russia agreement (Norway's share ~163 436 tonnes). If fully implemented, the 2026 quota would be below the 2025 figure which was already the lowest quota since 1991 at the time.

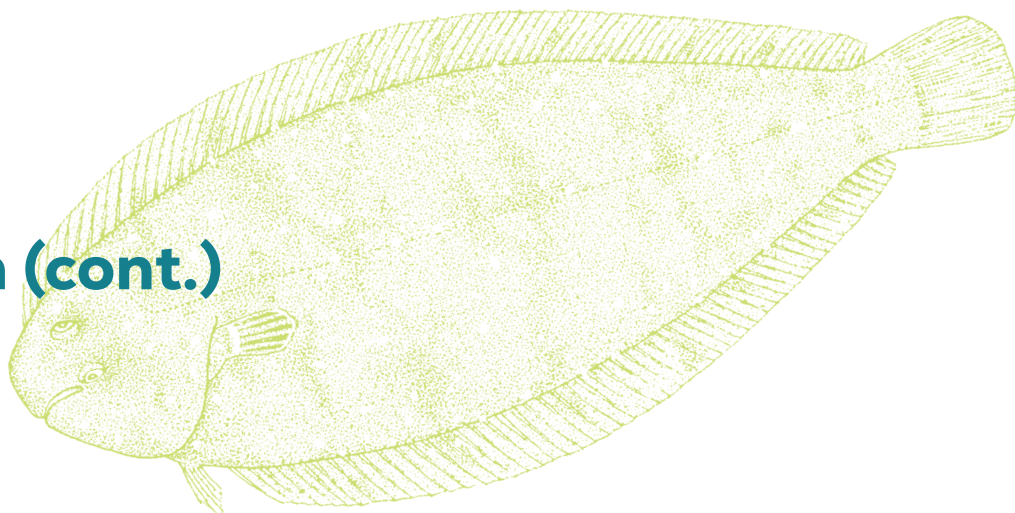
This scientific advice reflects ongoing concerns about spawning stock biomass being below precautionary levels and represents a further tightening of supply compared to 2025. As of late 2025, the Joint Norwegian–Russian Fisheries Commission had not yet finalized the 2026 quota due to political tensions between the two countries. However, both sides acknowledged the need to continue cooperation. Even if negotiations stall, quotas are unlikely to exceed scientific advice by much, as stock recovery is the priority.

Cod availability from the Barents Sea will thus remain extremely tight in 2026. Market prices are expected to stay high or rise further, especially given the ongoing sanctions on Russian fisheries and aquaculture products and limited alternative sources.

With regard to the North Sea cod quota for 2026, scientific advice from the International Council for the Exploration of the Sea (ICES) recommended near-zero catches due to critically low biomass levels. Negotiators compromised at 14 034 tonnes, a 44 percent reduction compared to 2025, in order to balance conservation with industry needs. Norway's share is 1 898 tonnes, while the European Union and the United Kingdom hold the remainder.

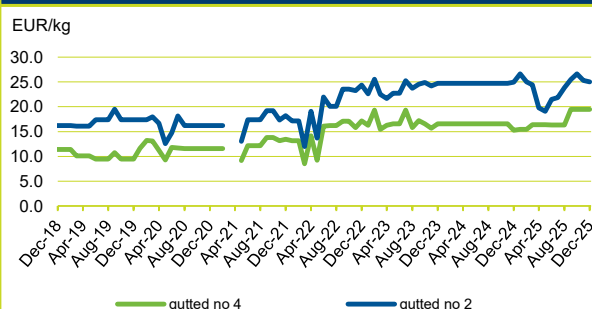
The Baltic Sea cod quota for 2026 has effectively been set at zero catches for both the western Baltic cod (subdivisions 22–24) and the eastern Baltic cod (subdivisions 24–32). Only minimal bycatch allowances are permitted, reflecting the dire state of the stocks. The western Baltic cod stock remains in critical condition, with no signs of recovery. The eastern Baltic cod stock biomass remains extremely low, with no improvement in recruitment. Aligned with ICES advice, the EU Council is maintaining a ban on directed fisheries.

Iceland's cod quota for the 2025/2026 fishing year has been set at 203 822 tonnes, a 4 percent reduction from 213 214 tonnes in 2024/2025, making it the lowest quota since 2013. Biomass levels are declining, and scientists expect further reductions over the next 2–3 years.

A bit more positive is the situation on the other side of the Atlantic. Canada has more than doubled its northern cod quota for the 2025–2026 season, setting the Total Allowable Catch (TAC) at 38 000 tonnes, up from 18 000 tonnes in 2024. This is the largest quota since the moratorium of the early 1990s, though scientists warn that the stock remains fragile.

The demand for clipfish is strong for the Christmas holidays, but in January, as every year, their consumption is expected to decrease. However, low temperatures are predicted, which will help boost demand for these products. Prices are expected to fall, especially for *Gadus morhua*, when fishing in the Lofoten Islands starts to bring a seasonal increase in supplies.

Trout

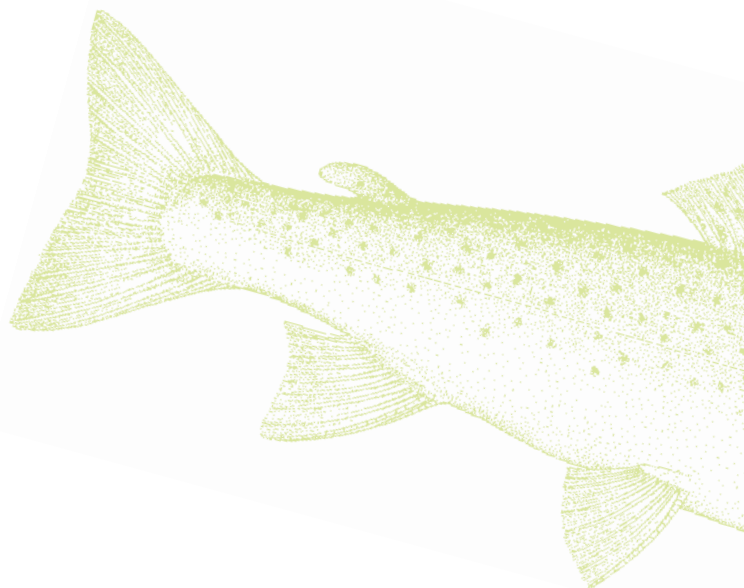


According to the (NSC, Norwegian trout exports in November showed year-on-year moderate value growth (+2 percent) despite a contraction in volumes (-3 percent), reflecting more selective demand and price support in key markets. Norway exported 6 320 tonnes of trout worth NOK 594 million (EUR 51.2 million) in that month, with Poland, the United States and Thailand being the largest markets.

Poland recorded the strongest growth in value, reinforcing the country's role as a key destination for trout; this is largely linked to its processing industry and onward distribution within Europe. Beyond Europe, Thailand continues to strengthen its position as an expanding Asian market for Norwegian trout, alongside salmon. According to the institution, the combined exports of salmon and trout have lifted Thailand to become the second largest market in Asia by volume, overtaking Japan and the Republic of Korea. Strong consumer preference and competitive pricing have supported Norway's growing market presence in the region, providing additional demand outlets for trout despite softer volumes overall in November.

NSC data disseminated by the Undercurrent News Price Portal indicate that prices for HOG fresh Norwegian trout, FOB at the border, stood at NOK 87.00 (EUR 7.50) per kg in week 49, broadly stable compared with the previous week.

Following a firm upward adjustment in mid-autumn, prices have remained at historically elevated levels through November, fluctuating within a narrow range around NOK 87 per kg. This relative stability suggests that price support has offset lower export volumes, underpinned by steady demand in core markets and limited short-term supply pressure.



Tuna

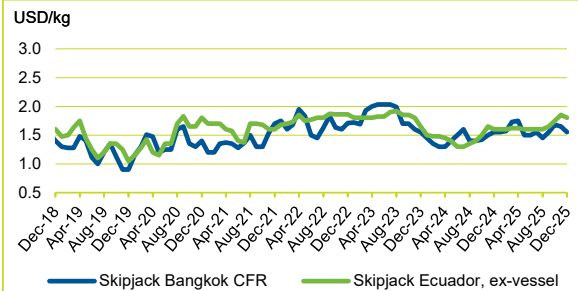
Lower fuel prices have had a stabilizing effect on the world tuna market. Skipjack prices in Bangkok are stable at USD 1 550 per tonne, which compares to USD 1 750 per tonne early in 2025. The reduced prices are also due to a post-holiday demand lull in Europe and the United States of America, combined with increased supply from the Indian and Pacific Oceans. EU and US buyers had completed their Christmas stocking early this year, leaving December in a seasonal demand vacuum. Prices in Manta, Ecuador, mirrored the Bangkok slide, at ~USD 1 800 per tonne, dockside. Market sentiment is bearish.

Lower raw material costs are providing short-term relief in the Thai tuna canning industry, but margins remain tight. Buyers in Europe and the United States may benefit from softer prices in early 2026.

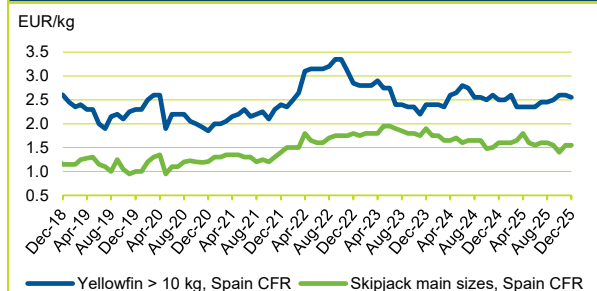
For yellowfin, demand was strong in December, especially from Europe. Nevertheless, prices also softened somewhat for this species, reportedly by USD 50 per tonne over the November price level. Further price declines are expected in early 2026, as the yellowfin quota in the Indian Ocean will be re-opened.

From early 2026, fresh tuna exports to the United States will only be allowed from fisheries certified under NOAA's Marine Mammal Protection Act (MMPA) comparability findings. Countries like Mexico, Viet Nam, China, India,

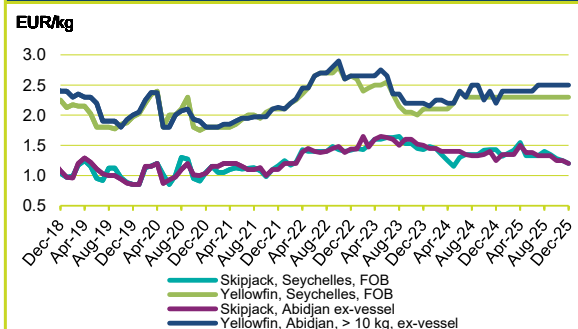
TUNA - Pacific Ocean

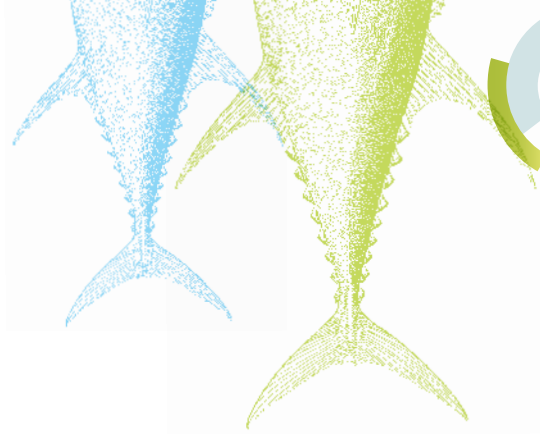


TUNA - Spanish canneries



TUNA - Indian/Atlantic Oceans

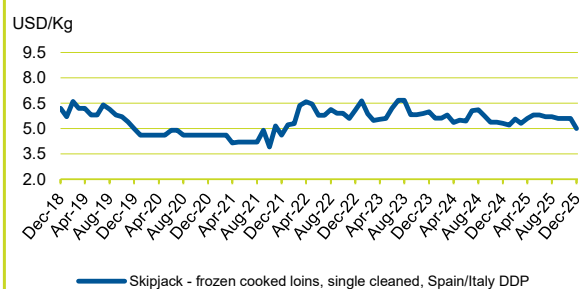

Indonesia, Mexico, Grenada and several African nations will be banned from exporting fresh tuna and other fisheries and aquaculture products to the US market. This will pave the way for additional quantities of high-value fresh tuna for direct consumption in the EU market in the coming months.

TUNA - Loins

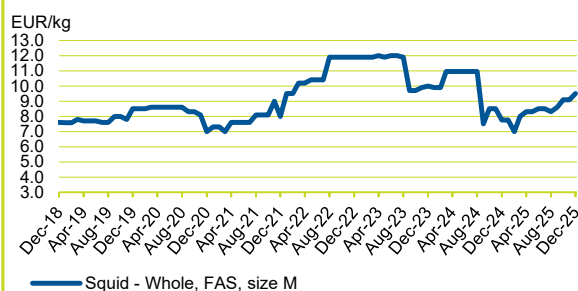


Demand for squid in Europe at the end of 2025 is strong but uneven, with steady retail and foodservice consumption driven by Mediterranean markets (Spain, Italy and France), while northern Europe shows slower growth. Imports are high, especially of frozen squid and cuttlefish, but prices remain elevated approaching the end of the year.

The squid season in South Africa opened on 22 November but catches are still very poor. Accordingly, only a few traders have container loads to offer. The South African currency is also firming up, reducing revenue even further. While prices of large squid are stable, the smaller sizes have experienced EUR 0.40 per kg price increases.

SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa





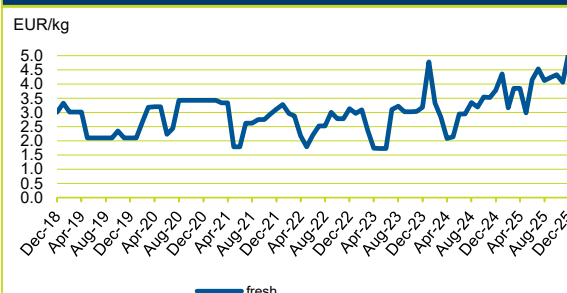
Small pelagics

Mackerel (*Scomber colias*) from Brazil are in strong demand in the domestic market, causing export prices to go up very quickly.

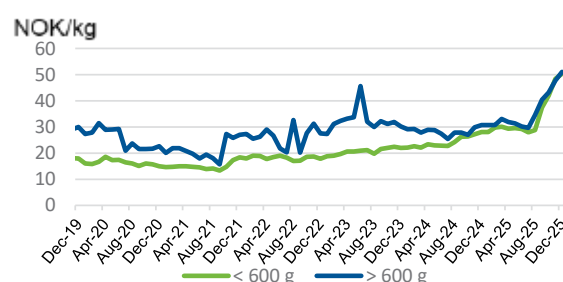
In November, Norway exported 52 700 tonnes of herring worth NOK 640 million (USD 63 million). During that month, the average price of whole frozen herring was NOK 8.14 (USD 0.80) per kg against NOK 7.28 (USD 0.71) per kg in November 2024, an increase of 23 percent. Consequently, though export volume fell by 2 percent, value increased by 8 percent compared with November 2024. Egypt, Poland and Lithuania were the largest markets for Norwegian herring in November. This strong demand is reflected in solid prices. According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), only once before has the average price for herring been higher in November than this year. That was in 2016, but then the quota was only 40 percent of what it is today.

There is also very good demand for Norwegian mackerel. With a record quota of over 300 000 tonnes in 2025, prices this year have been mainly below the 2024 levels. In November, however, prices rose sharply, exceeding last year's prices by a good margin. In terms of volume, Norway exported 43 100 tonnes of mackerel worth NOK 764 million (USD 75 million) in that month, down by 25 percent compared to November 2024. The Republic of Korea, Japan and China were the largest markets for Norwegian mackerel. With a record-breaking start to the season and high export volumes in August, September and October, exports had been expected to slow down somewhat in November.

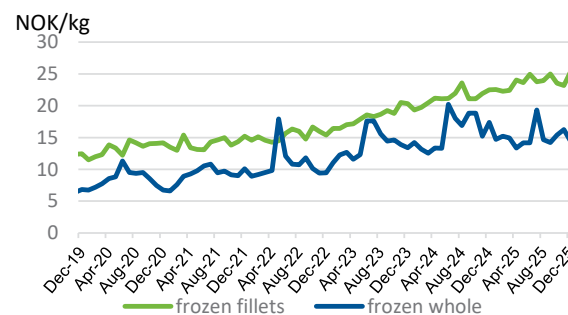
Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France

Crustaceans



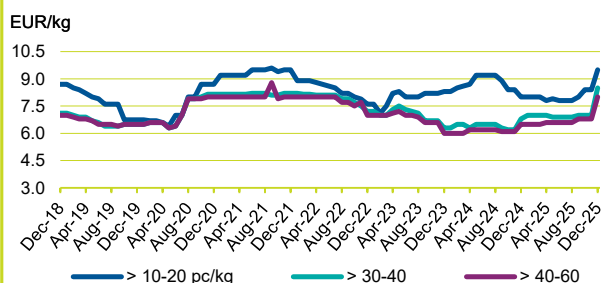
The European shrimp market experienced significant price increases in December 2025, after several years of a downturn. The price of *vannamei* tails in Italy went up by EUR 0.30 per kg in just one month, in view of the festive period. The same trend was experienced in other European markets. Similarly, Norway lobster is selling at about EUR 0.50 per kg higher than in November.

The delay in the start of the Argentinean red shrimp season has been further complicated by logistical problems arising from strikes in the port of Montevideo. Consequently, there are significant delays in shipments to Europe,

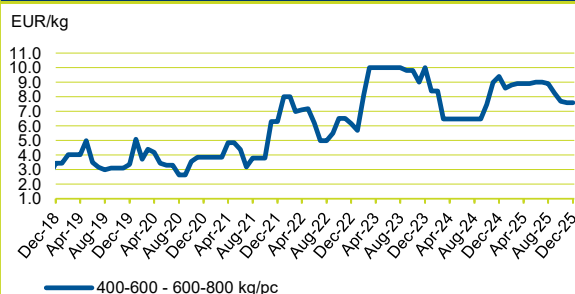
causing prices to rise for the Christmas period. In fact, prices have increased in just two months by EUR 1.00 to EUR 2.00 per kg, depending on the size of the shrimp. This is the first time in recent history that Argentine shrimp prices have reported such a major rise.

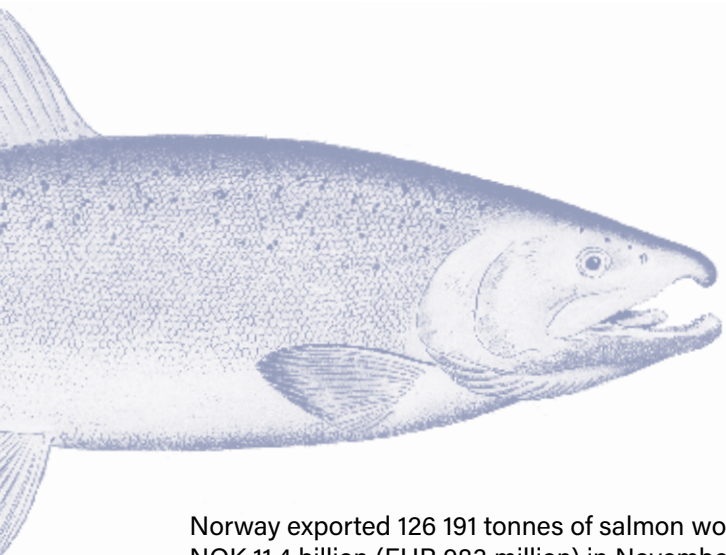
Live lobster (*Homarus gammarus*) from Europe is selling at sky-high prices, as is usual for this time of the year when demand is strong and supply is rather limited due to cold weather conditions. Prices of lobster have increased by EUR 3.00 per kg in just one month.

Salmon

Norway exported 126 191 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 11.4 billion (EUR 983 million) in November. Compared with the same month last year, export value fell by 4 percent, while its volume declined by 3 percent. According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), these declines reflect softer demand in traditional markets and an ongoing rebalancing of trade flows towards Asia. Poland, France and the United States remained the largest markets during the month.

Despite the overall contraction, China recorded the strongest growth in value, with exports increasing by NOK 165 million (EUR 14.2 million), equivalent to a rise of 35 percent year-on-year. Export volumes to China reached 6 598 tonnes, up 47 percent compared with November last year. NSC analysts indicate that this performance is part of a broader trend observed throughout 2025, with China continuing to expand its role as a key destination for Norwegian salmon, alongside solid growth in other Asian markets such as Thailand.

Asia's growing importance has also been reflected in the declining share of exports to the European Union. In November, the European Union accounted for 61 percent of the total export value, equivalent to NOK 6.9 billion (EUR 595 million), down from 66 percent in the same month last year. Over the same period, Asia's share increased from 18 percent to 21 percent, supported by stronger demand and improved availability of the salmon sizes preferred in Asian markets.

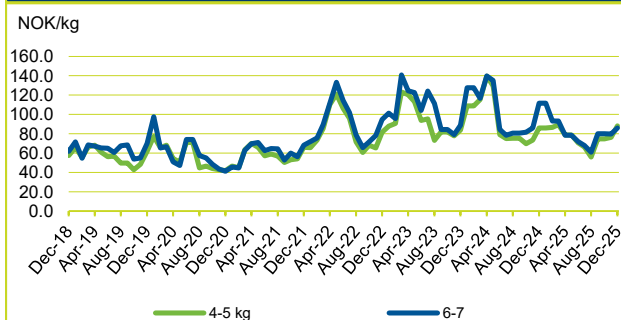
Within Asia, Thailand has continued to consolidate its position as a leading market for Norwegian salmon, having overtaken Japan and the Republic of Korea in terms of combined salmon and trout volumes.

From a trade facilitation perspective, the NSC highlights that salmon remains the backbone of Norwegian s exports of fisheries and aquaculture products . Recent progress in the electronic exchange of health certificates between Norwegian and Chinese authorities is expected to streamline trade flows with China, further supporting exports to this strategically important market.

Price trends remained supportive towards the end of November. NSC data disseminated by the Undercurrent News Price Portal show that prices for fresh Atlantic salmon, FOB at the border, rose sharply to NOK 92.26 (EUR 7.95) per kg in week 49, marking a 10.39 percent increase from the previous week.

After fluctuating through October and early November, prices strengthened markedly towards the end of the month, returning to elevated levels. This late-month recovery suggests renewed buying interest and tighter availability, partially offsetting weaker export volumes and reinforcing price support amid shifting demand patterns across key markets.

Salmon - origin: Norway



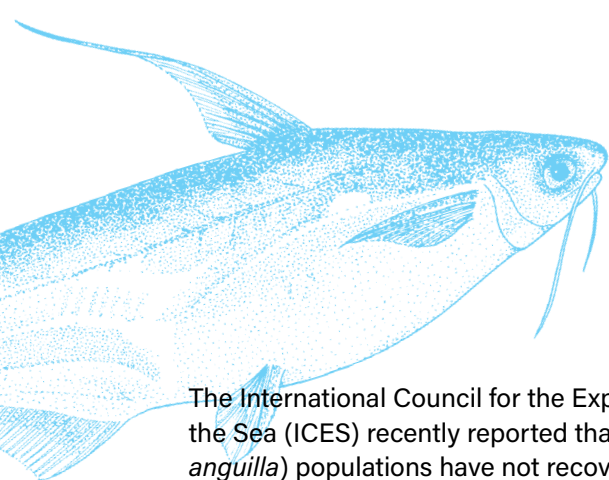
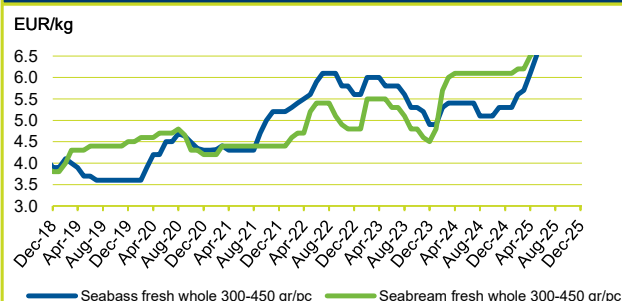
Seabass and seabream

Despite the holiday period, seabream and seabass are faced with limited demand. Prices of both species in the Italian market declined by about EUR 0.30 per kg in just one month (November). Wild seabream reported price drops of EUR 1.00–1.50 per kg; this is surprising as it is a perfect product for the restaurant trade, which is very strong during the festive period.

Seabass enters the Italian market mainly from Greece and Türkiye. However, the domestic supply continues to enjoy an interesting niche market, commanding prices which are two or three times higher than the levels for imported products.



SEABASS/SEABREAM Italy origin Greece



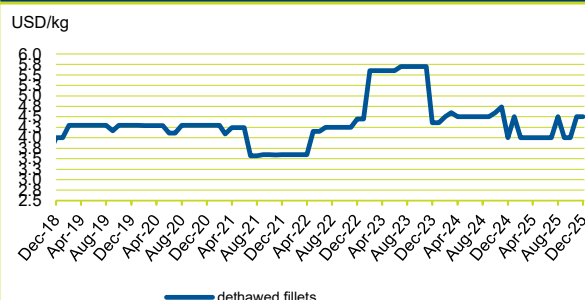
The International Council for the Exploration of the Sea (ICES) recently reported that eel (*Anguilla anguilla*) populations have not recovered since the 1980s, with larger eels (>50 cm) declining steadily in the Baltic and North Sea. The species remains critically endangered, and following ICES advice, in December 2025, the EU Agriculture and Fisheries Council is debating a total ban on eel fishing, both commercial and recreational. Current closures already prohibit recreational eel fishing at all life stages in EU waters, but exemptions exist for some Member States. Market prices are elevated due to scarcity.

Despite collapsing stocks, market demand remains strong, especially for glass eels (juveniles) used in aquaculture. In Spain, for

example, glass eel catches have fallen by over 90 percent since the 1970s, yet trade values remain high. The European eel market (shortfin and longfin combined) was valued at USD 7.3 billion in 2025, with projections of rapid growth in aquaculture-driven demand.

Pangasius - in Italy, origin: Viet Nam





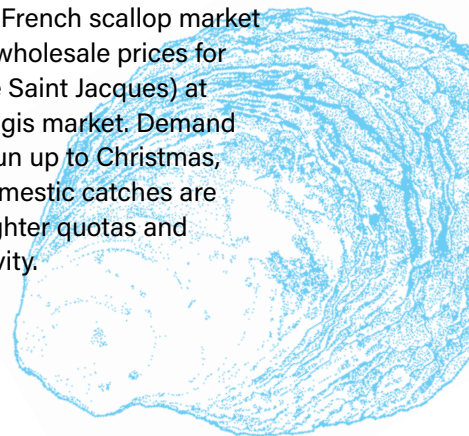
Bivalves

Clam prices in Italy have eased somewhat, but are still at high levels of over EUR 12.70 per kg for the Manila clam (*Ruditapes philippinarum*), which has been heavily impacted by the blue crab invasion in recent months. Two years ago in December, the prices were around EUR 9.00 per kg.

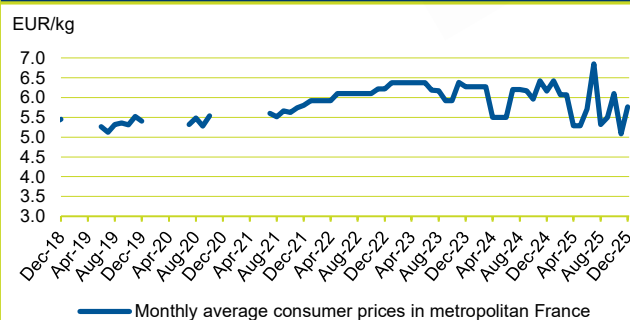
In December 2025, the Italian carpet shell clam (*Ruditapes decussatus*) market is stable but politically tense, with wholesale prices holding firm while supply chains face regulatory disputes. In contrast to Manila clam, the carpet shell clam comes mainly from capture fisheries and is not subject to the blue crab invasion. Italy remains Europe's largest producer and consumer of carpet shell clams but ongoing EU debates over minimum size rules and competition with Spain are creating uncertainty.

The Italian clam sector was valued at USD 1.2 billion in 2024. There is strong domestic demand at the moment, especially for use in holiday season dishes (such as *spaghetti alle vongole* and *risotto alle vongole*). Rising consumer preference for sustainable and locally sourced clams is boosting artisanal fisheries, while health-conscious eating habits are supporting steady consumption.

In December 2025, the French scallop market is stable but firm, with wholesale prices for fresh scallops (Coquille Saint Jacques) at ~USD 40/kg in the Rungis market. Demand remains strong in the run up to Christmas, though imports and domestic catches are under pressure from tighter quotas and consumer price sensitivity.
